WYATT JAIL

102 NORTH EAST STREET

SHERIFF L.L. WYATT BEGAN HIS CAREER
IN GREENE COUNTY IN 1925. HE WAS
RECRUITED TO STOP ILLEGAL CORN
WHISKEY. THIS BUILDING IS NAMED IN HIS
HONOR FOR ALL HE DID FOR THE COUNTY.



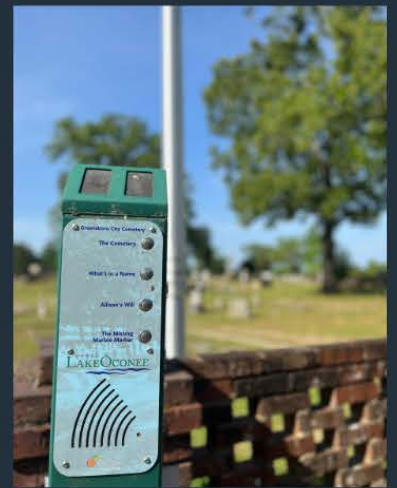

HISTORIC SPRINGFIELD CHURCH

314 CANAAN CIR

ESTABLISHED IN 1864, THIS HISTORIC AFRICAN AMERICAN CHURCH STILL HOLDS SUNDAY SERVICES WEEKLY.



GREENSBORO DEPOT

204 NORTH WEST STREET

BUILT IN 1917, THIS HISTORIC STRUCTURE IS ONE OF TWENTY-NINE ORIGINAL HISTORIC DEPOTS IN THE STATE OF GEORGIA.
